The two sportsmen Dinu Vlad and Tămaş Ciprian made the trip this year to the International Policeman and Firefighters Games held in Orlando USA between the 16<sup>th</sup> and the 23<sup>rd</sup> of August 2008. This competition brought together policemen and firefighters from all corers of the globe to compete in team sports (Baseball, Basketball, Football, Volleyball) as well as in individual sports (Athletics, Swimming, Judo, Weightlifting, Tennis, Sharp shooting, etc.).

Dinu Vlad's best result came in form of a silver medal at the cross country competition (5 km.) for the 30-34 years category. He also was granted a faire play medal for his behavior at the Sharp shooting competitions.

Tămaş Ciprian's efforts concluded in two bronze medals for weightlifting. Ciprian particitated at the Genoflexion – 275 pounds (125 kg), bench press – 300pounds (136.3 kg) and weightlifting – 450 pounds (204.5 kg) competitions. The medals were awarded by summing the results of all of the weightlifting competitions.
